Tips for caregivers to help kids learn through play!

Talk

- Talk about what creatures might live in a tree.
- Discuss what trees need to grow big and tall.
- Count aloud the stairs as you climb the different levels all the way to the top.

Play Together

- Find the metal talking tubes on the first and second level (station a person at each telephone).
 - Have a conversation OR
 - Make animal noises and guess the animal that makes that sound.
- Play "I Spy". What new things can you only see from up in the treehouse or by using the periscopes?

Explore

- Visit the different levels of the tree house.
 - How does your view and perspective change as you go higher? Why?
 - What new parts of the museum can you see?

Ideas to Learn Together Throughout the Children's Museum

- Let your child lead the way
- Ask open-ended questions that require more than a "yes or no" answer
- Let your child do the work
- Encourage safe risk-taking
