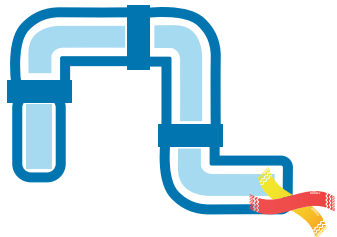

Sun Tubes

Tips for caregivers to help kids learn through play!

Talk

- Identify the colors of the scarves
- Ask "I wonder" questions - "I wonder what will happen when you put a scarf inside the tube?"
- Narrate the path of the scarf as it moves through the tubes: through, over, under, up or down, out...

Play Together

- Catch scarves as they fall; see if you can catch it with different body parts... on your head, on your shoulder...
- Practice sharing and turn taking

Explore

- Turn dials on Sun Tubes to change the path and then make predictions with your child about where the scarf will come out

Ideas to Learn Together Throughout the Children's Museum

- *Let your child lead the way*
- *Ask open-ended questions that require more than a "yes or no" answer*
- *Let your child do the work*
- *Encourage safe risk-taking*

SUN TUBES

The pneumatic (operated by air or gas under pressure) air system engages children and adults to explore the properties of air by inserting scarves and observing their path through the tubes.
