Can you reach the top?



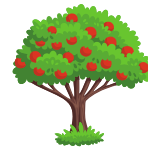
Harvest

Pretend to be a farmer and grow your crops to sell at the market.



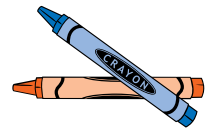
Apple Tree

Treat your pet patient by giving it medicine and an x-ray.



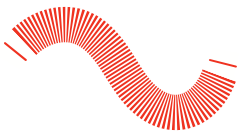
Wegmans

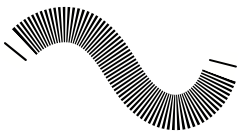
