Play I-Spy as you explore the cave.



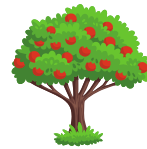
Playhouse

Work together to act out a story or performance.



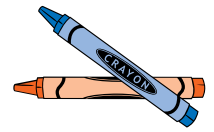
Apple Tree

Take turns being the customer and the cashier.



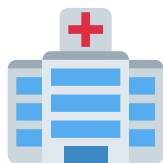
Sun Tubes

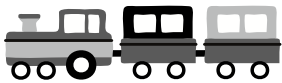
