ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

""Land, Air, Water" Sorting Activity

Have students group and compare different kinds of transportation. Students (or the teacher) can cut out the different kinds of transportation provided below. Then on the scene page, students can have fun arranging the boats, planes, and vehicles in the scene.

If you have access to a laminator, laminate the scene page and the vehicle pieces and keep this sorting game for future exploration time.

"Transportation Time" Movement Game

Using the circles on the template below, the teacher or chosen student holds up one vehicle (example: the image is a plane). Then the students act out the prompt for that type of transportation. (example: Fly like a plane)

Level up by asking questions befo	re students act/pretend, like
"What is this type of transportation?"	
"Does it belong in the air, water, or on land?"	
"If you were traveling by	, where would you go?"


