VOCABULARY

Key words to introduce prior to your visit

<u>Meteorologist</u>: an expert/ scientist who studies weather

Forecast: to predict or estimate

<u>Predict</u>: To say that something will happen in the future, to make an educated guess

<u>Season</u>: a division of the year marked by weather patterns, a result of the Earth's position to the Sun

<u>Cloud</u>: a visible mass of condensed water vapor floating in the atmosphere
