



Then, on the day after Thanksgiving 2005, Legendary Santa moved one last time to his new, permanent seasonal home at the Children's Museum of Richmond. All the trappings of the original Santaland are in place here at the Children's Museum: the ornate velvet chair, the chimney and fireplace, the souvenir photos and the festive holiday music.

Legendary Santa's followers come from across town, as well as from across the country. They all make their pilgrimage, from near and far, because of one pure and enduring belief: that this is the real Santa.

With your visit today, you become part of the rich tapestry of magic and tradition Legendary Santa has brought to generations of families.



# 12 YEARS OF Sensitive Santa





The tradition of visiting Santa during the Christmas season is not always easy for children with disabilities or sensory sensitivities. In an effort to make Santa more accessible to everyone, the Children's Museum of Richmond, hosts annual Sensitive Legendary Santa nights for children with disabilities.

We are very excited to be celebrating our 12<sup>th</sup> year of Sensitive Santa! Virginia Commonwealth University's Occupational Therapy program has been partnering with CMoR on this event since it began. During the Sensitive Santa evenings, VCU OT students volunteer their time to ensure that families have the support they need as their children play in the museum or if a child needs additional aids before visiting with Santa himself. Students also lead floor activities to meaningfully engage families while playing within the exhibit spaces.

Dear Friends,

As we approach the close of another fantastic year at the Children's Museum of Richmond, I am filled with joy reflecting on the many projects, adventures, and memories we've created together. Between the Downtown and Chesterfield locations, our team welcomed over 307,000 visitors, instructed 870 field trips, and facilitated countless moments of wonder. I view each of these touchpoints as an opportunity to spark curiosity, foster imagination, and empower our youngest learners and their caregivers. Thank you for supporting such a meaningful year!

You may have heard us mention once or twice that "learning through play" is a powerful tool, but this simple phrase really does capture a deeply intentional approach that drives everything we do. Research shows children learn best by moving, experimenting, and discovering, which is why every exhibit, program, and event we produce is infused with opportunities to practice problem-solving, reasoning, and patience, in addition to promoting early literacy and math skills. I am excited to share with you some of the ways we deepened this commitment to providing enriching educational resources to our community in 2024!

A highlight of our year was the refresh of the diner exhibits, reimagined as Seymour's Café with vibrant new imagery and enhanced educational offerings. New tabletop placemats now encourage kids to practice counting, grouping, and comparing, while wall graphics invite conversations about fractions, colors, and patterns – adding layers of learning to every playful moment.

Over the summer, we were thrilled to feature Bug Squad, a visiting exhibit that highlighted the amazing "superpowers" of insects. The immersive experience captured kids' imaginations while presenting STEM concepts in an approachable way for our audience. The lobby was truly buzzing with excitement!

At our Chesterfield location, we completed exciting upgrades to the Harvest Exhibit, including a matching game that encourages exploration of pollinators. Our tiniest visitors can now explore a newly expanded toddler zone, which allows them more room to develop sensory and motor skills at their own pace. We also added a Quiet Room to provide a calming, sensory-friendly space where children and caregivers can retreat when needed. Our Culture Fest Friday programming was another standout addition this year, drawing families to the museum each month to explore the dance, music, cuisine, and traditions of cultures around the world. These "mini-festivals" brought the community together and broadened children's understanding and appreciation of diversity in a way that was both fun and impactful.

This past year was certainly a remarkable one at CMoR, and it's been a pleasure sharing these highlights of our progress with you. Watching children engage with new hands-on activities and explore fresh concepts has been immensely rewarding.

Since 1981, it's been our privilege to serve the greater Richmond region, and as a nonprofit, we're enormously grateful to our supporters who make it possible for us to provide these safe, child-centered spaces where children and caregivers can play together, build essential skills, and grow better equipped to thrive in the classroom.


